A2 Clear in tone with the articulations, some unevenness in rhythms but the unisons were effective and there was momentum. It needed to be just a little steadier in pulse. 25

B2 The Waltz was sensitively played, with dynamic shape and with clear articulations and a consistent Allegro speed. The melody needed just a little more tone. 28

C3 Leggiero notes and cresc were heard with a glow. It was a little too fast for 'Andante' but the dolce was present and the rit. 26
